Phase System

Phase 1 (3.7 Level of Care)

- This phase will be 3-14 days.*
- This phase provides medically monitored withdrawal services 24/7.
- In this phase, the resident will receive a minimum of 10 hours of clinical group therapy weekly.
- In this phase, the resident will receive a minimum of 1 hour of clinical individual therapy weekly.
- The resident will receive a minimum of 10 hours of Peer Support group and individual sessions weekly.
- The resident will receive living skills group and other monitored structured activities weekly.

Phase 2 (3.5 Level of Care)

- This phase will be 15-30 days.*
- This phase provides monitored structured activity for 14 hours of the day.
- In this phase, the resident will receive a minimum of 10 hours of clinical group therapy weekly.
- In this phase, the resident will receive a minimum of 1 hour of clinical individual therapy weekly.
- The resident will receive a minimum of 10 hours of Peer Support group and individual sessions weekly.
- The resident will receive a minimum of 8 hours of living skills group weekly.

Phase 3 (3.1 Level of Care)

- This phase will be 16-75 days.*
- This phase provides monitored structured activity for 10 hours of the day.
- In this phase, the resident will receive a minimum of 5 hours of clinical group therapy weekly.
- In this phase, the resident will receive a minimum of 1 hour of clinical individual therapy weekly.
- The resident will receive a minimum of 8 hours of Peer Support group and individual sessions weekly.
- The resident will receive a minimum of 8 hours of living skills weekly.

Phase 4 (2.1 Level of Care)

- This phase will be 60-90+ days.*
- This phase provides monitored structured activity for 8 hours of the day.
- In this phase, the resident will receive a minimum of 3 hours of clinical group therapy for 3 days weekly.
- In this phase, the resident will receive a minimum of 1 hour of clinical individual therapy weekly.
- The resident will receive a minimum of 8 hours of Peery Support group and individual sessions weekly.

All of these services will be provided during the resident's stay at Beacons of Hope. We are able to transport the patient from your location Monday-Friday 8 am to 4:30 pm or with 24-hour notice for other times. We are a certified ADOE/BHSO and CARF accredited with approval to operate and provide 3.5 and 3.1 LOC for both men and women. As well as 3.7 LOC for medically managed treatment. Length of each phase depends on the individual progress in treatment. We are able to accommodate the resident for 120+ days to remain compliant with court standards. This facility also offers a Mommy and Me program. We can take up to 3 moms with babies up to 1 year old. Above phases can be adjusted to support the Mommy and Me curriculum. We look forward to serving Eastern Kentucky residents and developing lasting partnerships to help the addiction crisis.
